



## Kraken Bond Introduces Black Waterfall and Landscape Foam Sealant for Outdoor Projects

The introduction coincides with sustained expansion in residential water features. The global water features market was valued at approximately \$3.42 billion in 2025 and is projected to reach \$5.94 billion by 2034, growing at a compound annual rate of 6.9%, according to a report by Verified Market Reports. That growth reflects rising interest in backyard ponds, cascading rock formations and decorative landscape elements among homeowners and contractors alike.

The black waterfall foam sealant is formulated with dark pigmentation that helps it blend into stone, rock and water features, reducing the visibility of seams and joints. The product is engineered for UV resistance and

resistance to water and mildew, and it is intended to be safe for aquatic and terrestrial life once cured. It adheres to stone, concrete and other common landscape substrates, allowing it to secure rock work and seal gaps in water-feature assemblies.

"Outdoor water features present a specific set of challenges, from constant moisture exposure to the need for a finished appearance that does not distract from natural stone," said a spokesperson for Kraken Bond LLC. "This sealant was developed to address those conditions directly, giving builders a material that bonds reliably and stays visually unobtrusive in ponds and waterfalls."

The product is aimed at landscapers, hardscape contractors and do-it-yourself hobbyists who construct waterfalls, ponds and rock features. For professionals, the black pigmentation eliminates a common finishing step by concealing the sealant within dark stone and shaded water. For hobbyists, the material offers a straightforward way to secure rocks and close gaps without specialized equipment, supporting projects that range from small garden ponds to larger cascading installations.
